

The Art of Recycling One

Making a Decorative Candle Holder from a Tin Can

Adult Supervision Required



What You Need:

- Tin or aluminum can with top and label removed
- A nail
- A hammer
- A simple outline picture small enough to fit on the can
- Indelible markers (optional)

What To Do:

- 1) Fill emptied and cleaned can with water and place in the freezer until frozen solid.
- 2) Tape your chosen picture to the outside of the can where you want it.



- 3) Use a hammer and nail to punch holes in the can following the outlines of your picture. Do this outside on a grassy area so the can won't roll or damage furniture while you are hammering.
- 4) Let the ice thaw and empty the can. Place a candle inside and enjoy the glow.



Note: You can color your punched tin masterpiece by using indelible markers.
